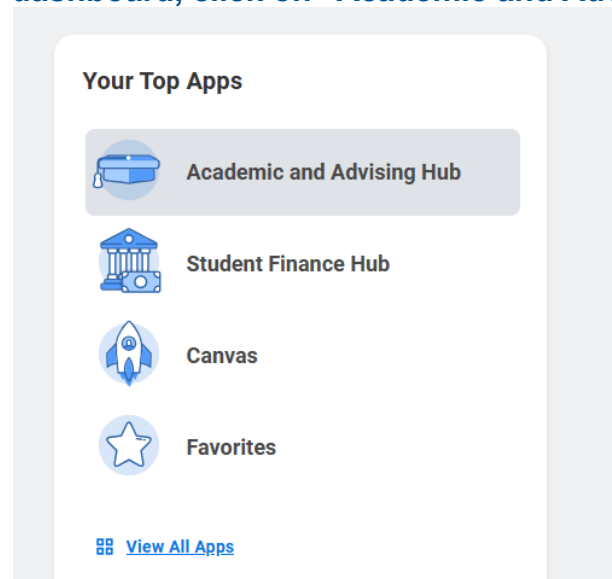
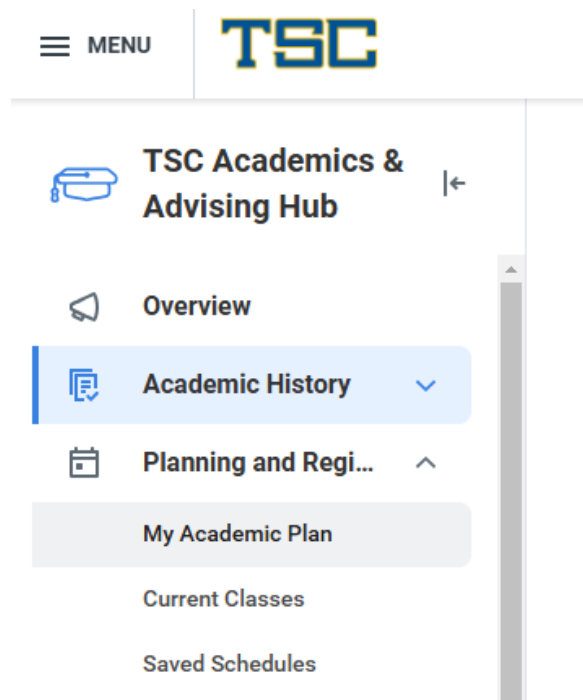


Two Ways to Register for Courses

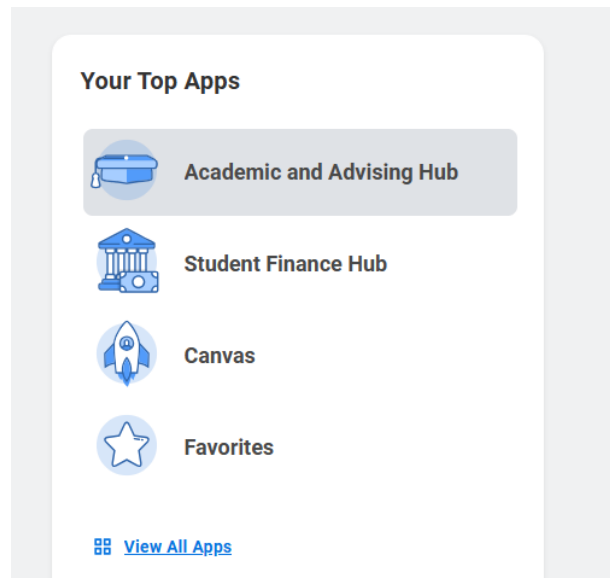

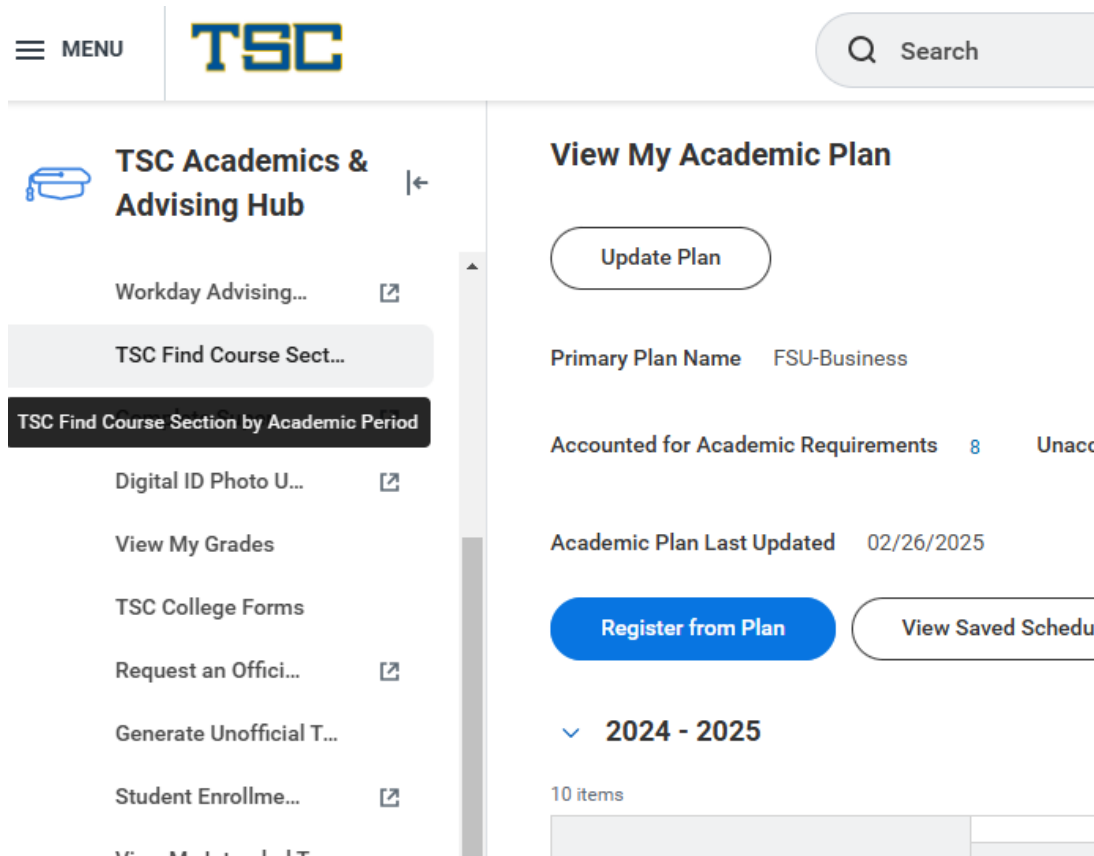
