SUBJECT: Academic Programs and Course Changes

## **Item Description**

This item presents proposed changes in curriculum for 2018-2019.

#### **Overview and Background**

The Academic Planning Committee Curriculum members review and make recommendations for Board approval for new program and courses. Due to changes by the State Board of Education as well as the revision of programs to meet workforce demands, there are several changes that are being proposed.

The College is proposing a new college credit certificate program: Digital Media/Multimedia. The program is 17 credit hours and will provide opportunities for students interested in music recording. Students will be able to obtain careers as Broadcast Technicians, Sound Engineering Technicians, and Audio and Video Equipment Technicians. There is a projected 5% growth for the region of Leon, Gadsden, and Wakulla, 7% growth for the State of Florida, and 12% growth for national employment projections. The salary ranges from \$24,000 to \$53,000 according to the Department of Economic Opportunity.

#### Past Actions by the Board

The Board approves the curriculum changes each year. The changes are for 2018-2019.

#### NEW PROGRAM

#### Digital Media/Multimedia College Credit Certificate (17 credit hours)

This certificate will provide opportunities for students interested in music recording technologies. Students will be able to obtain careers as Broadcast Technicians, Sound Engineering Technicians, and Audio and Video Equipment Technicians. There is a projected 5% growth for the region of Leon, Gadsden, and Wakulla, 7% growth for the State of Florida, and 12% growth for national employment projections. The salary ranges from \$24,000 to \$53,000 according to the Department of Economic Opportunity. TCC currently owns the equipment that will be used for this program. There are no industry certifications associated with this certificate program and no lab fees associated the courses.

#### PROGRAM DELETION

Based on a program review conducted by the Office of Institutional Effectiveness, this program is being deleted because the enrollment was low and steadily declining. Additionally, the Department of Education duplicated the skills and outcomes for this program in another program that TCC currently offers. Thus, this program is no longer needed at TCC.

#### **PROGRAM CHANGES**

<u>Sports, Fitness and Recreation Management, A.S. (60 credit hours)</u> – Based on information provided by the curriculum advisory group, which consists of recreation management employers, additional course options are needed to broaden the access to activities associated with careers in recreation. Currently, the program only offers activity courses related to Judo, Aerobics, Dancing, and Scuba Diving. Employers are asking TCC to add courses that represent a wide selection of games and skills as well as tournament design in order to adequately prepare students for the workforce. The new courses will be included in the list of electives for the AS degree. There are no lab fees associated with the new courses.
