Item Description

This item requests that the Board approve the receipt of funding for the listed projects.

Overview and Background

The following are recommended for approval:

I. Receipt, Amendment, Extension of Resources

Florida Department of Corrections - Vocational Instruction Amendment 1

This program amendment reduces the reporting requirements. This amendment does not impact the total amount of the award.

Florida Division of Emergency Management - Mobile Home Tie-Down Project 2018-2019

This award is to provide administrative support and implement the Mobile Home Tie-Down Project as described in Section 215.559, F.S., which provides inspections and improvements to tie-downs for mobile homes. The goal is to reduce property damage from high wind events. The amount of this appropriation is \$2,800,000, including an indirect cost rate of 10%. The funding period is from 7/1/2018 through 6/30/2019.

Florida Department of Law Enforcement – Region III Trust Award 2018-2019

This award will provide the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission (CJSTC) with approved advanced and specialized training courses through Florida Public Safety Institute for local law enforcement officers. The amount of the award is \$116,480, including an indirect cost rate of 0%. The funding period is from 7/1/2018 through 6/30/2019.

Florida Department of Law Enforcement – Region XV Trust Award 2018-2019

This award will provide the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission (CJSTC) with approved advanced and specialized training courses through Florida Public Safety Institute to law enforcement officers statewide. The amount of the award is \$289,440, including an indirect cost rate of 0%. The funding period is from 7/1/2018 through 6/30/2019.

<u>Florida Department of Education – Carl D. Perkins Postsecondary Vocational Education</u> Program

This award is to provide direct student support services and job placement for disadvantaged/special needs students. This project helps to develop academic, career and technical skills of students who elect to enroll in career and technical education programs. The amount of this award is \$317,944, including indirect cost rate of 5%. The funding period is from 7/1/2018 through 6/30/19.

II. Commitments, Expenditures, Contracts for Services

Past Actions by the Board

The above 2018-2019 awards are annually funded.

<u>Florida Department of Corrections - Vocational Instruction</u> was approved at the November meeting.

Funding/Financial Implications

The above projects are established in Fund 2, Restricted Accounts. The indirect earned from the above award and amendments is \$269,685.45.
