Course Outline:

This 2-day course is designed to train armorers to maintain, inspect, and repair the AR -15 Rifle. Students will learn the necessary skill sets required to act as their agencies armorer. Students are encouraged to bring weapon attachments or other repairs/issues they have experienced for class discussion.

Course Objectives:

- Understand the parts of the AR-15 rifle platform.
- Identify common areas of concern regarding maintenance and how to remedy any issues found.
- Best practices for logging weapon modifications and maintenance.

Students must bring their own rifle with them to class. If you anticipate having to test any modification bring enough ammo for the test.

Who Should Attend:

To attend this training the participant must be a Florida law enforcement officer, corrections officer, probation officer, or support personnel for a Florida law enforcement organization. For salary incentive courses, all officers outside Region III/XV must provide written authorization by agency representative requesting attendance and election of salary incentive or mandatory retraining.
