AIC students participate in a demanding progression of classroom and fast-paced physical training. The training covers both the principle and practice of different baton strikes, restraint application, and tactical flashlight use. This intense course includes multi-use drills, general tactics, and expert support in the event of litigation. You do not have to be a current user of ASP products to attend.

**This is an ASP factory-sponsored training—there is no charge to attend, and each participant will keep over \$300 worth of ASP equipment upon successful completion of the AIC.**
