Course Outline:

Cryptocurrency in Law Enforcement: Policy, Procedure, and Compliance is a practical, step-by-step training designed to help law enforcement agencies move from uncertainty to capability when dealing with cryptocurrency-related cases. This course goes beyond theory. Participants will learn how to build and implement a functional cryptocurrency program within their agency, including policy development, investigative processes, legal considerations, and wallet management.

Course Objectives:

- Build and implement agency cryptocurrency policies and why a dedicated crypto unit would be beneficial
- How to set up and manage agency wallets (Coinbase and others) to holding, investigative, and recovery purposes
- Track and document crypto evidence and property over multiple coin types

Who Should Attend:

To attend this training the participant must be a Florida law enforcement officer, corrections officer, probation officer, or support personnel for a Florida law enforcement organization. For salary incentive courses, all officers outside Region III/XV must provide written authorization by agency representative requesting attendance and election of salary incentive or mandatory retraining.
