Course Outline:

This course is designed to provide officers with the opportunity to improve their knowledge, skill, and abilities to become better firearms instructors or those who are interested in improving their firearms knowledge and foundational skills with their duty weapon. This course is designed to prepare experienced shooters to become effective shooters and trainers by covering topics such as teaching methodologies, coaching techniques, and how to diagnose and fix shooting errors.

You do not have to be a current firearms instructor to attend.

Required Equipment:

- 1500 rounds of pistol
- Duty weapon and 3 mags
- Iron sights or Pistol Mounted Optics allowed
- Vest, Duty Gear, eye and ear protection

Who Should Attend:

To attend this training the participant must be a Florida law enforcement officer, corrections officer, probation officer, or support personnel for a Florida law enforcement organization. For salary incentive courses, all officers outside Region III/XV must provide written authorization by agency representative requesting attendance and election of salary incentive or mandatory retraining.
