Course Outline:

This 40-hour CJSTC course is designed to provide an overview of general investigative procedures, explain how to rule out homicide in common cases, and proceed with non-homicidal death investigations. This course will also cover the medical examiner's role, the use of autopsy in an investigation, the common injuries and deaths that occur, and how to conduct yourself during a death notification and other interviews.

Who Should Attend:

To attend this training the participant must be a Florida law enforcement officer, corrections officer, probation officer, or support personnel for a Florida law enforcement organization. For salary incentive courses, all officers outside Region III/XV must provide written authorization by agency representative requesting attendance and election of salary incentive or mandatory retraining.
