Course Outline:

Once titled "Investigative Interviews", this 40-hour course (CJSTC 047) includes: a discussion of the interviewer, principles of interviewing, the interrogator, principles of interrogation, coping with deception, the admissibility of confessions and admissions. Patrol officers with limited experience and detectives alike will benefit from actual criminal investigation examples used to clarify the course content. This course may be counted towards salary incentive hours.

- This course will be instructed as four 10-hour days.

Who Should Attend:

To attend this training the participant must be a Florida law enforcement officer, corrections officer, probation officer, or support personnel for a Florida law enforcement organization. For salary incentive courses, all officers outside Region III/XV must provide written authorization by agency representative requesting attendance and election of salary incentive or mandatory retraining.
