### Course Outline:

This (3) day class is focused around the 8 light principles of Low/ No light. Developed by Ken Good, these tactics have been proven time and time again. Students will be exposed to extensive Force on Force scenarios utilizing airsoft pistols with Red Dot optics. Understanding the applications of the principles in this class, we will prepare students to be able to build and/or enhance their current low light programs. Handheld flashlight techniques will be discussed, however it will not be the focus. We will be focused around tactics with handheld and weapon lights. Students will be asked to demonstrate a level of proficiency in order to pass the class.

### Required Equipment:

- 300 rounds of pistol ammo
  - **Students must provide their own ammo**
- Pistol w/ red dot and 3 magazines
- Handheld flashlight is required
- Vest, Duty Gear, eye and ear protection, knee pads recommended.

### Who Should Attend:

To attend this training the participant must be a Florida law enforcement officer, corrections officer, probation officer, or support personnel for a Florida law enforcement organization. For salary incentive courses, all officers outside Region III/XV must provide written authorization by agency representative requesting attendance and election of salary incentive or mandatory retraining.
