Course Outline:

This course provides law enforcement officers, investigators, supervisors, and agency leadership with a comprehensive framework for understanding both the criminal and internal representation of officers involved in shooting situations, as well as the civil liability exposure that follows. Participants will gain practical insight into the rights of the officer, the duties of the investigator, and the procedures that should be followed when an officer or witness becomes involved in a line-of-duty shooting involving death or serious injury.

Course Objectives:

- Supervisor and agency role in OIS as well as officer rights
- Criminal representation and civil liabilities
- Memory loss and its impact on OIS
- Applicable case law and legal considerations for OIS

Who Should Attend:

To attend this training the participant must be a Florida law enforcement officer, corrections officer, probation officer, or support personnel for a Florida law enforcement organization.
