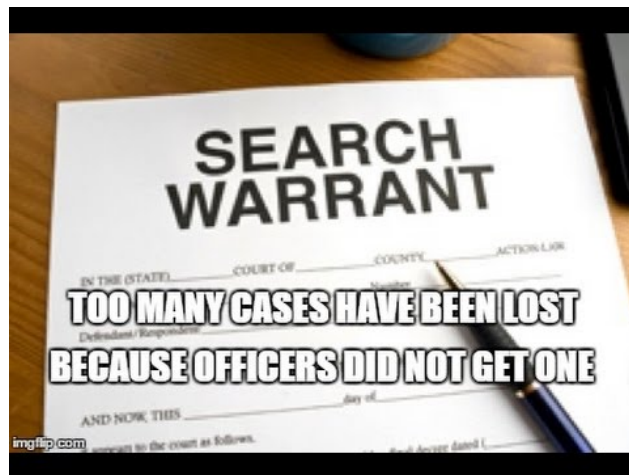

The Writing Drug Search Warrants course focuses on the fundamentals and constitutional requirements of obtaining drug related search warrants. The objective of the Writing Drug Search Warrants course is to expose the officer to the thought process of developing the elements of probable cause, articulating such facts in written form, understanding the contents and format of search warrants affidavits, exposure to the commonly used defense tactics in defending search warrants, introduction to a way of analyzing and understanding past court decisions for

upholding or suppressing evidence, and procedures in executing search warrants.

The course curriculum incorporates the most up to date legal aspects of search warrants. The course encompasses all aspects of writing drug related search warrants from a single location search warrant to multi-location conspiratorial drug related search warrants throughout numerous jurisdictions.
