Program Purpose:

To prepare students for the National Board Dental Hygiene Examination and for licensure as registered dental hygienists. To prepare students to safely and effectively perform all the functions that are legal for dental hygienists to perform in Florida. This program is accredited by the American Dental Association Commission on Dental Accreditation.

Admission Requirements:

Applicants to the Dental Hygiene program must complete all admission requirements to the College and must complete the program's required prerequisite courses with a minimum unrounded GPA of 2.2 and a minimum cumulative college GPA of 2.5. This program has a 15% denial rate.
