Students then apply to the [Emergency Medical Technician Applied Technology Diploma \(B312\)](#) after successfully completing EMS1059C

Then, after completing the [Emergency Medical Technician Applied Technology Diploma \(B312\)](#), students will be eligible to apply for the [Paramedic Certificate \(6309\)](#).

Finally, after completing the [Paramedic Certificate \(6309\)](#), students may then apply for the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Technology, A.S. (2104) degree program.

Program Purpose:

To prepare Paramedics who are competent in cognitive (knowledge), psychomotor (skills), and affective (behavior) learning domains to enter the profession.

Admission Requirements:

A student may declare the A.S. degree in EMS as his or her program of study at any time through the TSC Admissions and Records Office. The student is not officially admitted into the A.S. degree program until the student is enrolled in or has completed the TSC Paramedic program. The student must complete the TSC Healthcare Programs application by the published deadline to be officially admitted into the A.S. degree program.
