To prepare students for the examinations offered by the National Board for Respiratory Care for employment as registered respiratory therapists who can safely and competently perform patient care by applying scientific principles to prevent, identify and treat acute and/or chronic dysfunction of the cardiopulmonary system.

Admission Requirements:

Applicants must be at least 17 years of age at the time at the time of entry into the program, have completed all admission requirements to the College, have a cumulative, unrounded GPA of 2.5 for all college–level courses, and earn a grade of C or better in the three prerequisite courses listed. This program has a 50 – 60% denial rate.

Program Application:

The Respiratory Care program begins in the Fall semester. It is a limited access program with a limited number of seats per class. Applicants must submit a TSC Healthcare Program application by the published application deadline to be officially admitted into the A.S. degree program.
