

Answers:

1. Add together the top 3 economies and divide by the world total GDP:
 $(13.8 + 7.1 + 4.4)/65 = 38.92\%$
2. Take the Per Capita GDP of South Korea and divide by the Per Capita GDP of the US: $\$24,750/\$45,850 = 53.98\%$
3. Same method as #2: $\$14,400/\$45,850 = 32.11\%$
4. Same method as #2: $\$2,740/\$45,850 = 5.98\%$
