Project Description

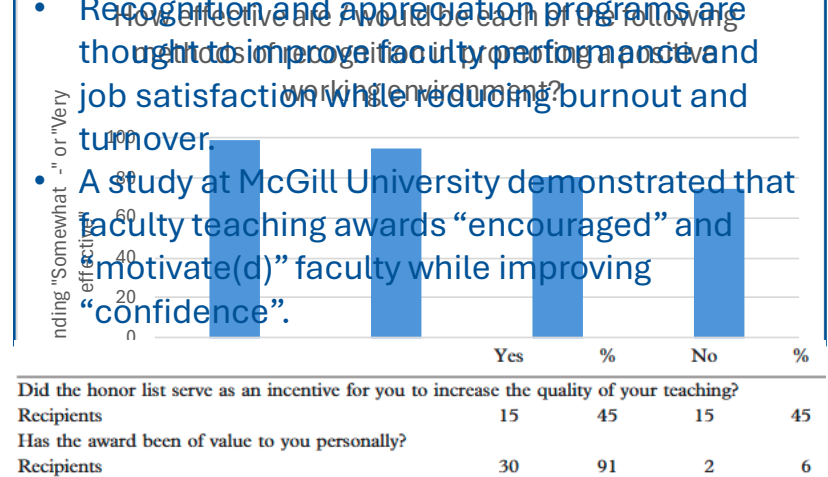
This project aims to enhance faculty recognition and visibility within the college by leveraging the resources of the Teaching and Learning Academy (TLA).

Key initiatives include:

- Soliciting **“Faculty Shout-Outs”** @ Stu-Fac Day
- Providing **recognition kits** to academic divisions
- Facilitating **personalized appreciation notes** from the Provost to faculty members
- Establishing a **Faculty Awards Night***

Rationale:

- Recognition and appreciation programs are thought to improve faculty performance and job satisfaction while reducing burnout and turnover.
- A study at McGill University demonstrated that faculty teaching awards “encouraged” and “motivate(d)” faculty while improving “confidence”.
