Project Description

This project aims to enhance faculty recognition and visibility within the college by leveraging the resources of the Teaching and Learning Academy (TLA).

Key initiatives include:

- Facilitating personalized appreciation notes from the Provost to faculty members
- Establishing a Faculty Awards Night*
